We report with rigor, clarity, and urgency, and we're looking for an editor who brings the same energy to the role.

JTA serves not only a direct audience through 70 Faces Media's platforms, but also plays a central role in the Jewish media ecosystem as a syndication wire service, with content republished by 60+ partner publications around the world.

The ideal candidate is a nimble journalist who can move seamlessly between editing, assigning, and writing — someone who knows when to jump in with a sharp headline, a clean rewrite, or a smart story of their own. This is a hands-on, supervisory role: You'll help shape our editorial priorities, manage our breaking news reporter and ensure that JTA's daily report is fast, thoughtful, and indispensable.

This position reports to JTA's Editor-in-Chief and works closely with colleagues across 70 Faces Media, JTA's parent organization and the largest nonprofit Jewish media company in North America.

- Write breaking news, short features, or explainers as needed
- Supervise a staff reporter and develop a network of freelancers across time zones
- Monitor global news developments and make real-time editorial decisions
- Ensure accuracy, clarity, and audience relevance in all published stories
- Collaborate across teams to expand reach and engagement
- Help uphold and evolve JTA's editorial standards and syndication value

- A strong news sense and ability to move fast without sacrificing quality
- Excellent writing and line-editing skills; can craft a sharp lede and shape a story on deadline
